### Stall Barn

### Stall Bedding

Shavings are \$10.00 per Bag for the Large compressed bag (large and small flakes mixed each bag).  
All Stalls will be Pre-bedded with two (unopened) bags per stall, and will be charged at the \$10 per bag rate for the two pre-bedded bags.  
Additional shavings may be ordered on-site through Will Rogers Shavings Office  
No Outside Bedding Allowed. Will Rogers Memorial Center will monitor outside shavings and will charge for all outside shavings at \$12 per bag.

### Vehicle Parking

Negative EIA/Coggins within 12 months.  
For horses coming in from outside the state of Texas, Negative EIA/Coggins within 12 months and Certificate of veterinary inspection within 30 days prior to entry.
